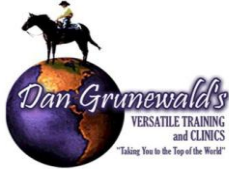

## Show Rules & Other Information



### Division High Points:

- 1) Division high points are offered in 6 divisions each show: Tiny Tot **W/T** (12 & Under), Youth **W/T/C** (13 & under), Jr. (14-18), Sr. (19-39), Select (40 & Over) and Ranch (all ages).
- 2) Awards will be given for Grand and Reserve High Point in each of the divisions.
- 3) Points are based on horse/rider combination.
- 4) Each horse/rider combination may nominate themselves for no more than one high point division.
- 5) **No crossovers between Divisions.** Must choose only one division for high point.
- 6) Division high point fee is \$12 per horse/rider combination.
- 7) Each horse/rider combination must sign-up for division high point before showmanship begins.
- 8) Only certain classes count for division high point (see table for details).
- 9) In case of a tie for division high point, the higher placing exhibitor in showmanship wins.

### Team Challenge:

- 1) Each team must consist of two exhibitors from the same division (ex: 2 exhibitors from Jr., or 2 exhibitors from Ranch).
- 2) Awards for the highest number of points overall among all divisions will be presented as grand and reserve team.
- 3) Team challenge fee is \$15 per exhibitor.
- 4) Points are based on horse/rider combination.
- 5) A horse/rider combination may not compete on more than one team.
- 6) **No crossovers between Divisions.**
- 7) Teams must sign up for Team Challenge before showmanship begins.
- 8) Only certain classes count for Team Challenge (see table below).
- 9) In case of a tie for Team Challenge, the higher placing(s) in showmanship wins.

### Important Show Information:

- 1) **\*\*Tabs will be closed at end of show day\*\*** Awards must be picked up at end of show\*\*
- 2) Ranch Horse Pleasure entries **MAY NOT** cross-enter into English/Western Pleasure classes and vice versa
- 3) No Crossovers between Tiny Tot and Youth Divisions.
- 4) **Shootout classes need a minimum of 7 entries to run the class.**
- 5) Ranch Riding W/T/C **MAY NOT** enter Ranch Riding W/T and vice versa.
- 6) If you enter Lead Line or Tiny Tot classes you can't enter into a 3-gaited class.
- 7) Separate Fair Entry collected at the gate.
